3. HAIR MUST BE PULLED BACK FROM FACE AND IN A SLICK BUN OR PONYTAIL AT ALL TIMES DURING REHEARSAL
4. CELL PHONES ARE ON SILENT & OFF OF THE BODY DURING ALL REHEARSALS
5. NO SWEARING
6. NO GUM CHEWING
7. NO DRINKING OF SODA OR ENERGY DRINKS DURING ANY COLORGUARD RELATED ACTIVITY
8. NO TALKING WHEN INSTRUCTORS OR CAPTAINS ARE TALKING
9. NO EATING OR DRINKING (OTHER THAN WATER) IN UNIFORM
10. NO PDA
11. YOU MUST NOTIFY A CAPTAIN IF YOU ARE GOING TO BE LATE TO ANY REHEARSAL
12. ANY NO SHOW AT A REHEARSAL WILL POSSIBLY RESULT IN YOUR REMOVAL FROM THE TEAM
13. YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SHOW UP 10 MINUTES EARLY TO REHEARSAL UNLESS YOU HAVE NOTIFIED A CAPTAIN OR INSTRUCTOR
14. YOU ARE REQUIRED TO GIVE 100% AT ALL REHEARSALS
15. REMEMBER WHO YOU ARE AND WHAT YOU REPRESENT
